LAS VEGAS (November 4, 2008) – As it marked 10 years of service to Latin America, Gaming Laboratories International, together with GLI South America, recently hosted nearly 40 regulators from across the region at the first Latin American Regulator’s Roundtable and New Technology Workshop. Regulators from Argentina, Chile, Panama, Paraguay and Peru were in attendance. The event coincided with the SAGSE and MAGIA tradeshow, and GLI had a strong presence at both events.

The Roundtable took place in the official facilities of the Provincial Institute of Lottery and Casinos of the Province of Buenos Aires in La Plata City, Argentina, which is the Regulatory agency in the jurisdiction of the Province of Buenos Aires.
